EVENT E: UDVAR HAZAY AIR & SPACE MUSEUM & MEMORIAL SERVICE

Saturday, May 22nd (1030-1700)

Udvar-Hazy is the National Air and Space Museum's newest facility, located at Dulles International Airport. The museum has over 80 aircraft and dozens of space artifacts on display, including an A6 Intruder, a SR-71 'Blackbird', the B-29 Superfortress 'Enola Gay', Space Shuttle Enterprise and many more. You can walk among the displays on the floor and view hanging aircraft from elevated walkways (skyways). The buses will depart the museum promptly at 1400 to the *Viet Nam Memorial* for a special Memorial Service. Tour cost is for transportation.

EVENT F: WASHINGTON ON YOUR OWN & MEMORIAL SERVICE

Saturday, May 22nd (1030-1700)

There is so much to do and see in Washington, DC we are leaving Saturday afternoon open for those who wish to visit on their own. The motor coach will depart the hotel at 1030 and drop you at the *Viet Nam Memorial* which is located close to many of the museums and other Memorials on the Mall area. Meet your group back at the *Viet Nam Memorial* at 1500 for a special Memorial Service. Following the service, the buses will depart from the *Viet Nam Memorial* to return to the hotel. Tour cost is for transportation.

Please note: You have the option of departing the hotel at 12:00pm for those who wish to leave a bit later. Please select the later departure on your reservation form if this is preferable.

RECEPTION & BANQUET DINNER

Saturday, May 22nd (1930 at the Hotel)

EVENT G: GETTYSBURG TOUR

Sunday, May 23rd (0900-1700)

For those of you who can stay an extra day. John Fitzpatrick has offered to provide a guided tour of the *Gettysburg Battlefield*. The *Battle of Gettysburg* was a turning point in the American Civil War, a conflict that determined the fate of the United States. *Gettysburg National Military Park* is the site where these two great armies clashed, and is a symbol of America's struggle to survive as a nation. You will travel over 18 miles amongst the 1,000 monuments and cannons as you experience the 3 days of the battle. You will also have time

to see the new *Visitor's Center & Museum*. The center offers many additional exhibits, a film, and bookstore. The *Refreshment Saloon*, located at the *Visitor's Center*, offers snacks and sandwiches for lunch on your own.

ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

For those who prefer to make up their own itinerary, there is commercial bus transportation (Fairfax Connector Route 505) from Reston Town Center to the West Falls Church station on the METRO Orange line. Bus cost is \$1.35 each way, per person. Exact change or METRO SMARTRIP Cards are required. Buses depart every 30 minutes beginning at 5 AM. Last bus weekdays from West Falls Church back to Reston is 11:50PM. If you have your own transportation, there is ample free parking at Reston Town Center and at the Hyatt Regency.

TOUR CANCELLATION INSURANCE

Protect yourself from unforeseen expenses caused by sickness, injury or any other causes that impact your travel plans. This insurance enables a refund of Tour & Banquet expenses up until three (3) days before the start of your reunion. If you need to cancel – please call our office immediately (817-251-3551) for a cancellation number. If you have not purchased cancellation insurance all tour and meal money is non-refundable 6 weeks prior to the reunion.

- ~ Tours may be cancelled if a minimum of 30 people per bus is not met. In this case, full refunds will be given.
- ~ Please understand that a certain amount of walking is necessary from the bus to attractions and in some instances, to also see the attractions. Please consider your abilities before purchasing tours.

- ~ All tour times are subject to change. A final itinerary is available at registration.

Reservations are due by April 16th, 2010. Late reservations accepted on a space available basis with a non-refundable \$10 per person late fee. You should make a copy of this form for your records.
